Malalotja Zip-Line Adventure

For the adrenaline junkies



Intro

This tour has a bit of everything and covers the best and most beautiful parts of Eswatini (formally Swaziland). Visit Sibebe Rock, the kingdom's most iconic landmark and Maguga its largest dam. The highlight of the trip, is the exhilarating Zip-line Canopy Tour! 10 cables and 11 platforms will take you whizzing through a beautiful gorge from tree top to cliff edge experiencing mountain scenery like never before!

OVERVIEW/ITINERARY

The north western mountains of Eswatini are what most people consider the most beautiful area of the country. Wide open grasslands, and rolling mountains dotted with rural homesteads and cattle herds gives the feel and experience of "typical" Eswatini.

Day 1 - This tour begins in Ezulwini at 13:00 and passes the capital Mbabane before descending into Pine Valley where you'll have a chance to see Sibebe Rock which is the second largest exposed rock in the world (after Uluru). From there the tour takes a gravel road deep into the rural hills before a gentle meander down the famous Komati Valley where you'll have a quick tour of Maguga Dam. You'll then head west for the impressive mountain ranges of Malalotja Nature Reserve, one of Eswatini's true wilderness areas. Here you will find game viewing and incredible views. You will stay in wooden cabins and you'll be served a delicious traditional Swazi braai (BBQ) prepared by your guide, for dinner.

Day 2 -After an early breakfast prepared by your guide, you will head to a full safety briefing at 08:15. You will get kitted up in all the gear before jumping into an open game viewing vehicle to drive to the start point. A short walk takes you to the first of 10 cables, ranging from 10 to 130 meters in length. You'll zip at speed over an incredibly beautiful gorge providing the perfect mixture of fun and adrenalin. After traversing over the stunning valleys you will jump back on the vehicle and return to reception in time for a light lunch. After boarding the main vehicle, drive to Ngwenya Glass Complex to see the work of local artisans, many of whom are supported by Eswatini Fair Trade. The trip ends with a final adventure as you take a short drive to the oldest recorded mine in the world (Lion Cavern) ending the trip with a bit of archaeology and history of Eswatini. Drive back to your accommodation / agreed drop off point mid-late afternoon.



Perfect for: Individuals or groups looking to experience the stunning Malalotja Region, especially the adrenaline junkies.

Included: Zip-line Canopy Tour, accommodation and entry at Malalotja, 3 meals, experienced guide(s), transport in an air-conditioned vehicle, visit to Sibebe Rock, Maguga Dam, Ngwenya Glass Factory and the "Lion Cavern" which is the oldest recorded mine in the world

Excluded: Drinks, snacks, meals not in the itinerary
General Info: Low risk malaria area, Malaria free, bring active outdoor clothing, hat, sun cream and trainers or walking shoes, toiletries and towel.
