Explore this incredible park on daily sunrise to sunset game drives, and optional bush walks(subject to availability). This is Kruger done the proper way.

YOUR CATERED SAFARI

Mornings start with tea, coffee and rusks before you head out on your early morning safari followed by breakfast that may include cereals, yoghurt, muffins, eggs or toast. Lunch will be tasty wraps, salads or rolls with fresh seasonal fruit and dinner will be pot meals with rice, pap or pasta or something on the barbeque, all accompanied by a delicious side salad. Our guides can cater for a range of diets including vegan, gluten free and lactose intolerant, as long as we know at least 48 hours before your trip.

Perfect for: Individuals or groups wanting to enjoy more than a day taster trip, and love the idea of sleeping to the sounds of wildlife

Included: Camping fees, park entry fees, conservation fee unlimited daily game drives, 1 x night drive, meals (wh in Kruger but not in transit to and from the park), camping equipment, guide(s), all transport from start to end point.

Excluded: Drinks, snacks, meals not in the itinerary, mornir walking safari (dependent on availability - book early secure your spot).

Any visas, vaccinations and associated certificates and its validity is the responsibility of each individual guest and should be in place 48 hours before the trip departs. Most nationalities, except border countries, require a visa, obtainable at an Embassy prior to travel.

OVERVIEW

Kruger is classified as one of the world's superparks and is home to Africa's iconic Big 5; elephant, lion, buffalo, rhino and leopard. The park covers an area of about 2 million hectares of African wilderness and has a greater variety of wildlife than any other African national park.

This camping safari is all about wildlife and outdoor adventure. We will take you on a guided adventure in an open safari vehicle (OSV), where you get up close and personal with the park. Our professional and passionate Kruger guides (FGASA trained) will explain and interpret what is going on in the natural environment around you.

We venture right into the heart of Kruger viewing the spectacular scenery which provides a perfect backdrop for incredible wildlife sightings. The Kruger Park has approximately 147 species of mammals (more than any other African national park), 500 species of birds, 114 species of reptiles, so there are plenty of opportunities to experience wildlife in their natural habitat. In addition to the Big 5, cheetah, hyena, wild dog, giraffe, large herds of zebra and wildebeest, and an impressive variety of antelope are among our usual sightings.

Get the full experience of Kruger by joining the early morning, full day, and night safari over the next 5 days. We also recommend the optional morning walking safari for those who wish to get even closer to the wilderness.

At night you will sleep under the stars to the sounds of roaring lions, snorting hippos and the soft croaking of frogs in the river. The camp is fully fenced and it is safe to walk around and explore the different viewpoints and attractions.

A truly amazing wildlife experience awaits you in the Kruger National Park.





ITINERARY

On this 5-day group campingsafari you get a chance to enjoy the highlights of Kruger National Park. The days are fully packed with a variety of experiences that will give you an everlasting memory of an African safari.

Day 1 – Departure from Mbabane (7:30) and Ezulwini (8:00), **Eswatini (formerly Swaziland) travelling through the scenic northern part of the Kingdom.**

After a brief stop at Komatipoort we head to Crocodile Bridge Gate for our safety briefing and to board the OSVs. We start our safari as soon as we enter the gates, enjoying a 2 hour game drive before arriving into camp. On arrival into camp you will assist with setting up your tent and finding your luggage. There will be time to explore camp with your guide. Relax around the campfire and enjoy dinner under the stars.

Day 2 – Rise with the sun and join a full day game drive safari with breakfast and lunch at remote picnic sites, where animals roam around us.

We arrive back at camp mid/late afternoon in time for a swim in the camp's sparking pool or you can choose to enjoy the sunset from the camp's wooden deck overlooking the river. Once again we have dinner around the campfire sharing stories of the day's amazing sightings.

Day 3 – This day is similar to Day 2, however we explore new and different areas of the park during the day. By late afternoon it is time to join the exciting sunset / night safari, looking for Kruger's nocturnal creatures There is no pressure to join every safari outing today or tomorrow, although most like to do so.


Day 4 – Once again we head out at sunrise for a short morning drive, before returning to camp for breakfast. On this day it is it may be possible to join the optional Morning Walking Safari. The afternoon is flexible, and you may want to spend time by the pool or doing another short game drive from camp.

Day 5 – On the last morning we get up early again and enjoy a short game drive (or you can choose to have a lie in). After breakfast we all help pack up camp and take our last safari as we head out of the park. Say goodbye to your guides and hop on the vehicle for the drive back to Eswatini.

ACCOMMODATION

Camping in 2 person canvas safari tents, comfortable mattress and pillow provided. There are hot showers and clean toilets, camp chairs a gazebo kitchen complete with fridge, cooker and storage boxes, as well as charge points in camp.
